Exciting Changes on sciencdo.com Publishing Platform!

We are thrilled to share news of significant improvements to our publishing platform, particularly focusing on book and journal pages. We extend an invitation to you and your readers to explore the upgraded visual aesthetics, enhanced navigation, and improved functionalities.

Books Pages: the main book page and chapter pages have been updated for a more engaging user experience. We've introduced a shopping cart for readers interested in acquiring paid access books directly on the sciencdo.com platform. In the first half of 2024, we plan to extend this model to accommodate a print-on-demand option.

Journal Pages: journal pages have undergone a comprehensive makeover with the following enhancements:

- **Featured Articles** – This section allows you to personally choose papers for promotion to a broader audience. If this tab is currently hidden on your page, it indicates that it is empty. Please reach out to your Customer Service Specialist to populate this tab with your selected papers.
- **Newest Articles** – Presents six papers from the most recent issue.
- **Top Cited** – The tab displays the six most cited papers in your journal, updated daily through integration with Crossref. The search in Crossref's database is based on the journal's current ISSN number. In case your journal changed the title and the ISSN in the past, the search for top-cited papers will not encompass articles published under the previous ISSN number.
- **Most Downloaded** – The tab highlights the six most downloaded papers from your journal on sciencdo.com platform. The counter is triggered each time a download occurs. Please bear in mind that for full-text XML papers, the number of PDF downloads might be smaller, as readers can access the text directly on the screen.

Upcoming Feature: Book Series Page - in the next phase, we will introduce a dedicated page for book series, offering a comprehensive view of related titles within a series.

XML Fast Track service

XML (Extensible Markup Language) is a text-encoding format that facilitates data exchange across various platforms and websites. In academic publishing, it is used for automatic delivery and content indexing in libraries and abstracting services, increasing discoverability. The format also enables better control over the structure and quality of published documents, becoming an invaluable tool for editors and publishers.

Benefits of the XML format

Academic papers can be published either partially (only metadata) or fully in the XML format. Converting the whole documents into the XML format is advantageous and brings additional benefits:

- **The XML format is mobile-friendly** – the text adjusts automatically to the device's screen size, enhancing the reading experience. Meanwhile, PDF files need to be scrolled, which makes them difficult to read on the go.
- **Texts in XML are screened by search engines** – users of academic content utilize various methods to reach the content they are interested in. Some look for specific journals by opening their web pages directly, some check the contents of indexing databases, and others prefer to use the search engines, such as Google. In the latter case, only papers available in XML format have the chance to be discovered and read, as search engines do not have the possibility to scan PDF files. Publishing metadata in XML (and the article body in PDF) is not always sufficient, as readers may want to search for keywords or phrases that are not accessible in the title and abstract.
- **The XML format can be read aloud by screen readers** – this functionality enables all readers, including those with different types of disabilities to access your research output. Sciendo's publishing platform is compliant with the latest accessibility standards and hence provides a screen reading component that reads texts available in XML.

The room for improvement

The XML format provides many advantages to those academic publications that decide to use it. A major disadvantage of this standard is the time required for additional document formatting, taking anywhere from a few days to even a few weeks, depending on the publisher. During that time journal editors and authors need to wait for their publications to become available online.
